Best Practices for Setting Up and Using LCPtracker Pro to Comply with CA AB-219


Assign the Appropriate Concrete Delivery Wage Classifications for the Project

1. Determine the batch plant location(s) for your project's concrete deliveries.
2. Determine the Wage Classification, wage requirements, fringes, and DAS Training requirements for Concrete Deliveries from the identified County Locations.
 - a. [Statewide determination and provision selection page \(ca.gov\)](#)
3. Add the batch plant counties (Location) to the project to assign the CA wages.

Contractor View

When entering the payroll record the contractor will need to make sure that they select the correct location – if contractors have already entered payroll records, one thing to note is that the new location added will be added in alphabetical order which means it may or may not come before the original location.

CPR

If the incorrect location has been selected, then the CPR will need to be deleted – the location CAN NOT be edited.

The CPR will show one craft and classification and the location that was selected when entering the payroll

Validations and Validation Exceptions

- a) Concrete Delivery contractor/vendor will typically need individual validation overrides for Val_5 and Val_23 in the LCPtracker Pro system, due to the non-standard fringe calculations required for Concrete Delivery drivers.
 - i) VAL_5. Validates Total Hourly Rate (basic plus fringes)
 - 1. Advise to set to "Warning/Notice" rather than ignore
 - ii) VAL_23. Checks that the Total Hourly Rate in the database is sufficient.
 - 1. Advise to set to "Warning/Notice" rather than ignore
